

Directions Between Stresa and Orta San Giulio

NOTE: A rotary is also called a circle or roundabout.

From the Grand Hotel des Iles Borromees in Stresa to the Hotel San Rocco in Orta San Giulio:

Note: There is also a mountain road between these two points, but I don't have these directions. It's a more scenic route, but is on narrow, curvy roads.

- 1) Travel northbound on the road that parallels Lago Maggiore.
- This road is called #33. Stay on this for 7 kilometers (about 10 minutes).
- 2) At the rotary, take a left in the direction of Gravellona Toce.
- Stay on this for 4 kms. (about 5 minutes).
- 3) At the rotary, take a left in the direction of Omegna/Lago d'Orta.
- Stay on this for 2.5 kms. (about 5 minutes).
- 4) At the rotary, take a left in the direction of Borgomanero.
- You are on road SR 229. Stay on this for 13.5 kms. (about 10 minutes).
- 5) Make a right at the light to Orta San Giulio. It's the only light for kilometers.
- Stay on this road for 1.5 kms.
- 6) Take a right at the Hotel San Rocco sign. There is a mini-golf at this turn.
- You have arrived at the Hotel San Rocco.

From Hotel San Rocco in Orta San Giulio to the Grand Hotel des Iles Borromees in Stresa:

Note: There is also a mountain road between these two points, but I don't have these directions. It's a more scenic route, but is on narrow, curvy roads.

- 1) From the hotel, go to the main road and take a left at the light.
- This road is called SR 229 and you're on this for about 9 kilometers (about 10 minutes).
- 2) At the fork, take a left in the direction of Gravellona Toce.
- Stay on this for about 8.5 kms (about 10 minutes).
- 3) At the rotary, take a right and follow signs to Stresa.
- You're on this for 10.5 kms. (about 15 minutes).

The Grand Hotel des Iles Borromees is visible on the right.
